Provide volunteer lawn and garden care services for the elderly and disabled who cannot perform the services for themselves and/or cannot afford to pay for the service otherwise

Provide volunteer small home repair services for the elderly and disabled homeowners who cannot afford to pay for the service otherwise.

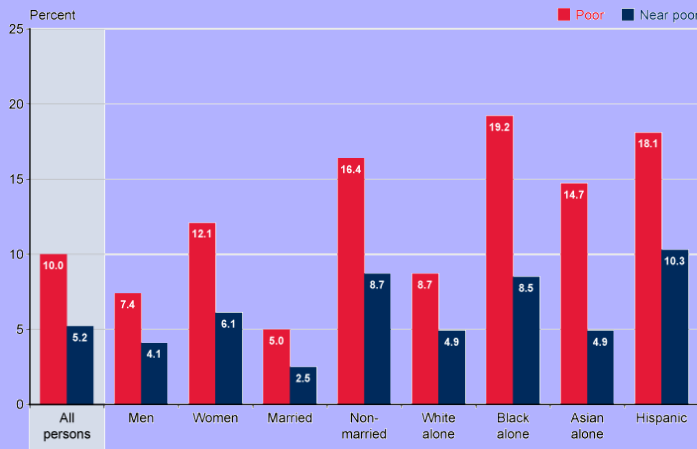
Provide lawn and garden care services for families living at or below the poverty level who cannot perform the services for themselves at little to no costs.

Provide small home repair services for families living at or below the poverty level who are homeowners and who cannot afford to pay for the services otherwise at little to no costs.

Harnett County is ranked the 64th poorest county in the state with 16.4% of its citizens living below the poverty level. 12.5% of the citizens are 65 years old and over and 12.5% of the citizens 65 years old and over live in poverty. We want to fill in the gap.
